**Item 9**

We disclose the following matters taken up in a Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of Globalport 900, Inc. (the "Company"), held on 13 March 2020, during which a quorum was present:

**I. Impact of the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the Company**

There are no cases reported to the Company of any officer, employee, and persons comprising the majority stockholder of the Company (the directors of Sultan 900 Capital, Inc.), who tested positive of COVID-19.

There are no cases reported to the Company of other stockholders, who tested positive of COVID-19, which are reported to the Company.

As of the date of the execution of this report, there is no visible impact on the Company operations, brought by the said COVID-19 pandemic.

**II. Preventive Measures to be Implemented to Manage the Risks of Contagion Brought by COVID-19**

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, the following guidelines shall be disseminated to the employees, directors and stockholders of the Company:

1. Practice frequent and proper handwashing – wash hands often with soap and water for at 20 seconds. Use alcohol-based sanitizers if soap and water are not available;
2. Practice proper coughing/sneezing etiquette:
  - a. Cover mouth and nose using handkerchiefs or tissues (sleeves or crook of the elbow may also be used if the former is unavailable).
  - b. Move away from other people when coughing/sneezing.
  - c. Spit at proper places.
  - d. Dispose of used tissues properly.
  - e. Always wash your hands or sanitize after coughing/sneezing.
  - f. Use alcohol/sanitizer frequently.
3. Maintain distance of at least one meter away from individual/s manifesting flu-like symptoms;
4. Avoid unprotected contact with farm or wild animals (alive or dead), animal markets, and products that come from animals (e.g. uncooked meat);
5. Drink plenty of fluids;
6. Eat nutritious food;
7. Ensure that food is well-cooked;
8. Maintain a healthy lifestyle. Increase the body's resistance by having adequate rest and at least eight (8) hours of sleep; and
9. There is also a flexible work schedule that the Company has implemented, maintaining a skeletal work force, where employees and officers shall alternate reporting for work at the office.

The employees, directors and stockholders of the Company shall likewise be apprised if there are additional guidelines concerning the management of the risks of COVID-19, as announced by the Department of Health, and other pertinent government agencies.
